Rating Scale: 1 = Marginal 2 = Acceptable 3 = Average 4 = Above Average 5 = Excellent

Scoring Criteria:

- **Excellent** (demonstrates superior creativity, originality, or understanding in approach, content, or presentation)
- **Above average** (demonstrates creativity, originality, or understanding beyond basic expectations in all areas)
- **Average** (meets basic expectations for presentation, approach, understanding and content and goes beyond expectations in one or two of these areas)
- **Acceptable** (meets basic expectations for understanding, presentation, approach and content)
- **Marginal** (below average in presentation, approach, understanding or content)

Rating*	Criteria
	Introduction/background: (e.g., clearly states purpose or motivation for study; presents background needed to understand research)
	Content: (e.g., concise, logically organized; approach, hypothesis, methodology, results are clear)
	Conclusions: (e.g., findings clearly stated, consistent with results; mentions future research directions)
	Visual Aids: (e.g., layout; appropriate amount of information; effective use of graphics; conforms to conventions in grammar, punctuation and spelling)
	Presentation Style: (e.g., good poise, effective interactions with viewers; organized explanations; can communicate with general audience)
	Responses to Questions and Comments: (e.g., confident and effective response to questions)
