**Dr. Wendy Troop-Gordon** joined the Human Development and Family Studies department at Auburn University in 2017. She received her Ph.D. from the University of Illinois and spent fifteen years as a faculty member at North Dakota State University. Her research focuses broadly on peer relationships in childhood and adolescence, including peer victimization, bullying, popularity, and friendships. Her most recent projects focus on social-cognitive and psychobiological traits that moderate the link between peer victimization and psychosocial adjustment and the application of novel clinical theories to increasing defending behaviors among children when they witness bullying.
