Call for Abstracts: Abstracts must be prepared in LaTeX using the template provided on the conference website.

Accommodation: There is a variety of choice of accommodation within walking distance from the conference venue (University of Pretoria, Hatfield campus). Delegates will have to organize their own accommodation. However, some options will be posted on the conference website.

Post-Conference Proceedings: The date for submission of full papers to be published in the SAMSA 2016 conference proceedings is 31st October 2016. The papers should be in LaTeX and the template is provided on the SAMSA website, <http://www.samsa-math.org>.

Invitation/acceptance letters for visa purposes: If you require a visa to enter South Africa, write to the SAMSA Secretary copied to the Secretary of the Local Organizing Committee.
