CLOTH FACE MASKS ARE NOT INTENDED TO PREVENT THE WEARER FROM CONTRACTING DISEASE. THEY ARE INTENDED TO LIMIT THE SPREAD OF DISEASE.

WEARING AND HANDLING



- WASH HANDS BEFORE HANDLING THE CLOTH FACE MASK.
- SECURE SNUGLY BUT COMFORTABLY AGAINST SIDES OF FACE.
- WASH HANDS BEFORE REMOVING THE CLOTH FACE MASK.
- DO NOT TOUCH EYES, NOSE AND MOUTH WHEN REMOVING FACE MASK.
- PLACE IN CLEAN BAG OR CONTAINER BETWEEN USE.
- WASH HANDS IMMEDIATELY AFTER REMOVING CLOTH FACE MASK.



REUSE AND CLEANING

- WASH CLOTH FACE MASKS DAILY IN A WASHING MACHINE.
- USE THE WARMEST APPROPRIATE WASH SETTING.
- FOLLOW THE MANUFACTURER'S INSTRUCTIONS FOR BEST FABRIC CARE.
- DRY FACE MASKS COMPLETELY BEFORE STORING.
- STORE FACE MASKS IN A CLEAN BAG OR CONTAINER BEFORE USE.



CLOTH FACE MASKS CAN BE MADE FROM FABRICS, T-SHIRTS, AND BANDANAS.
